

Example of classification of loan account as Non –Performing Assest (NPA) and Special Mentioned Assest (SMA):

## Example of NPA

For E.g.: Mr. A has obtained term loan of 5 lakhs from the bank on  $1^{st}$  January 2021. Equated Monthly Statement (EMI) of the loan is 10000, of which the Principal is 8000 and the interest is 2000. Due date of repayment of EMI by Mr. A is  $5^{th}$  February of every month.

## Scenario 1

If Mr. A. fails to pay interest component of the loan, i.e. 2000 or any such amount arrived at by the bank on or before the due date and only the <u>interest</u> component applied at specified rests (i.e. whether daily or monthly or yearly) remains overdue for a period more than 90 days, the account would be classified as NPA

Or

## Scenario 2

If Mr. A. fails to pay principal component of the loan, i.e. 8000 on or before the due date and only the <u>principal</u> amount remains overdue for a period more than 90 days, the account would be classified as NPA

Or

## Scenario 3

If Mr. A. fails to pay principal and interest component of the loan (EMI), i.e. 10000 or any such amount arrived at by the bank on or before the due date and the <u>entire EMI</u> remains overdue for a period more than 90 days, the account would be classified as NPA.

The date of SMA/NPA shall reflect the asset classification status of an account at the day-end of that calendar date.

For E.g.: Example: If due date of a loan account is March 31, 2021, and full dues are not received before the bank runs the day-end process for this date, the date of overdue shall be March 31, 2021.

If it continues to remain overdue, then this account shall get tagged as SMA-1 upon running day-end process on April 30, 2021 i.e. upon completion of 30 days of being continuously overdue. Accordingly, the date of SMA-1 classification for that account shall be April 30, 2021.

Similarly, if the account continues to remain overdue, it shall get tagged as SMA-2 upon running day-end process on May 30, 2021 and if continues to remain overdue further, it shall get classified as NPA upon running day-end process on June 29, 2021.
